occasion.

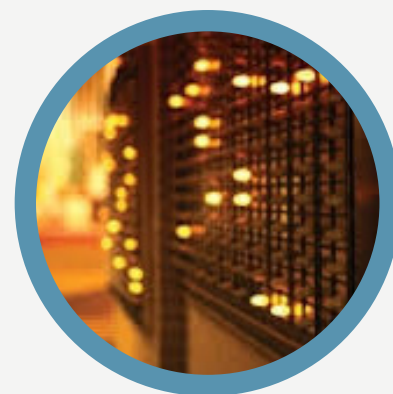
The **Tree of Remembrance** is also a beautiful way of
