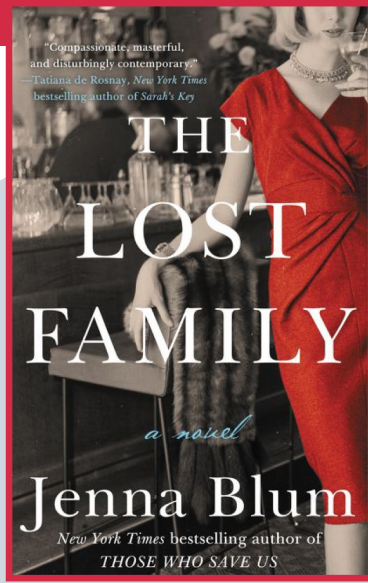


# Sisterhood Book Club

Sisterhood's upcoming Book Club meeting will be moderated by Debi Stadlin as we explore *The Lost Family* by Jenna Blum. Set in 1965 Manhattan, *The Lost Family* follows Auschwitz survivor Peter Rashkin, and his life as a restaurant owner in New York City after the Holocaust. *The Lost Family* features a husband devastated by a grief he cannot voice, a frustrated wife competing with a ghost she cannot banish, and a daughter sensitive to the pain of her family, and another child lost before she was born. Spanning three decades, *The Lost Family* is a charming, funny, elegantly bittersweet study of loss and love.

Jenna Blum is a *New York Times* and internationally bestselling author of the novels *Those Who Save Us* and *The Stormchasers*. Blum's novels have been published in over 20 countries and she is one of Oprah's Top Thirty Women Writers. She was a featured speaker at the recent Jewish Book Festival.
